

General Policy

- 1- Travelers who are fully vaccinated with the below approved vaccines shall be exempt from quarantine in the event of a period of (14) days has elapsed after receiving the second dose of a two-dose vaccine or from a single dose in the case of the single-dose vaccine:

- 2- *Serology Antibody test with a positive result is mandatory before travelling to Qatar for people with two doses of a conditionally approved vaccines and 14 days after the second dose, in which case only the traveler will be considered fully immune.
- 3- *People who have received two doses of a conditionally approved vaccine followed by one dose of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine and after 14 days from the last dose will be considered fully immune.
- 4- Travelers who are fully immunized outside Qatar with a vaccine approved by the Ministry of Public Health of Qatar are required to submit the original vaccine certificate and other supporting documents written in Arabic or English proving that they have obtained the vaccine, as follows:
- The name of the traveler must be identical to that on the passport.
 - Dose dates by vaccine type (one dose for Jansen vaccine and two doses for other vaccines).
 - Type/name of vaccine.
 - The serial number of the vaccine batch (if any).

B. Unvaccinated travelers - entry is not allowed	

Before Travel

- 1- A PCR test must be conducted at an approved medical center by the local Ministry of Health in the country of departure 72 hours before travelling to the State of Qatar

- 2- To facilitate entry procedures into the country, the online pre-registration on Ehteraz website (www.ehteraz.gov.qa) is mandatory for all visitors (12) hours before travel to obtain a travel permit. The passengers will be required to download all official documents and present the travel permit to the airline employees (in case of travelling through Hamad International Airport). Ehteraz application policies

- 1- Passengers coming to Qatar must download Ehteraz app and activate it on their mobile phones upon their arrival at the Port of Entry (PoE). To achieve this, the passenger must obtain the following:
 - a. A Qatari SIM card from a local telecommunications operator (Ooredoo or Vodafone) which can be obtained at the duty free in the arrival terminal in Hamad International Airport
 - b. Access to the Internet
 - c. A smartphone that supports Android 6, newer versions or IOS 13.5 and above.
 - d. Download the app on the mobile either via Google Play, Apple App Store or from any online search engines
- 2- The health status in Ehteraz app for visitors vaccinated abroad shall remain green without a golden frame until their vaccination data is updated in the system
